Proposed Water Use Efficiency Goals

The following goals are proposed for the time period 2017 to 2023. The goals will be presented and discussed at the meeting. The goals were written by the Treasure Island Country Club water department and have been reviewed and approved by the Club's Board of Trustees:

- **Goal:** Reduce total water consumption by 2% from 2017 to 2023.
- **Goal:** Obtain and maintain a Distribution System Leakage (DSL) amount equal to or less than 10% for the period 2017 to 2023.
- **Goal:** Work with customers to identify and repair customer leaks.
