Maintenance of Roadside Ditches

Purpose:

To clarify and define herbicide use for the maintenance of the TICC roadside ditches.

Policy:

Controlling the growth of flora in the roadside ditches is critical to the efficient flow of rainwater to drain boxes. Also, keeping standing water at a minimum will help reduce mosquito infestation that standing water breeds.

Control will be accomplished by the spraying of an "over the counter" herbicide by an employee of TICC who is familiar with the product, using equipment provided by TICC for that purpose. Spraying will occur in the spring and in the fall.

Notification of spraying will be posted at least one week prior on the TICC website. Signs will be placed on the bulletin board at the island-side stop light and at the water tank at the top of the hill. Additional signs may be placed as deemed appropriate.
